DOUNREAY COMMUNITIES FUND



Are you a community-based organisation or charity that benefits people in Caithness and North Sutherland?

If so, you may be eligible for assistance from the Dounreay Communities Fund.

Who can apply?

The fund aims to assist charitable activities and local organisations that will improve the quality of life for people living in the Dounreay travel-to-work area (Caithness & North Sutherland). Applications intended to benefit people outwith this area will not be considered

Donations will not be made to individuals unless they are under the age of 18 who require assistance to represent their community at regional, national or international events and will be eligible for assistance up to 50 per cent of the cost.

How much?

It is designed for small-scale community projects with a total cost of up to £5000.

Below £1000

Assistance from the fund will normally be 50 per cent, but each request will be considered on its own merit. A receipt will be required for the agreed amount.

£1000 - £5000

A copy of audited accounts will be required. Assistance from the fund normally will be 50 per cent, but higher levels may be available in exceptional circumstances. The donation will be paid on receipt of an invoice for the agreed amount.

The fund is provided by the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority and is supplemented by UKAEA through a workforce safety dividend at Dounreay.

The fund is administered by UKAEA in association with the Dounreay Stakeholder Group, a body set up to represent the community in site issues which will meet quarterly to consider applications.
