

**POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL ACT 1999
POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2000 (“the Regulations”)**

In accordance with Paragraph 4 of Schedule 7 to the above Regulations, Notice is hereby given that application has been made to the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) for variation to Permit PPC/B/1009244 under regulation 13 of the Regulations by Dounreay Site Restoration Limited in respect on activities being carried out namely blending cement in bulk other than at a construction site in an installation at Dounreay Cementation Plant, Dounreay, Thurso, Caithness.

The changes in the operation proposed by the application are:

- To change the location of Emission Point A01 from the 55m stack to a new replacement stack;
- To change the location of spot particulate sampling for Emission Point A01 from the primary sample line on the 55m stack to a sampler at the point of exit from the facility ductwork; and
- The method of storage and opening lime bags within the facility.
